That for the purpose of paying the sum of #24/. •• , being the amount charged against the said lands so to be beneted as aforesaid, other than belonging to the municipality, and to cover interest thereon for *3* years at the rate of *5* per centum, the following special rates, over and above all other rates, shall be assessed and levied (in the same manner and at the same time as taxes are levied) upon the undermentioned lots and parts of lots, and the amount of the said special rates and interest assessed as aforesaid against each lot or part of lot respectively shall be divided into *3* equal parts and one such part shall be assessed and levied as aforesaid in each year for *3* years after the final passing of this by law, during which the said debentures have to run.
