


Petition for Examination by Engineer.

To *John Moynahan* Township of *Sandwich South*, Oct. 15th, 1895

SIR,

I am within the meaning of "The Ditches and Watercourses Act, 1894," the owner of lot number *two* in the *8th* Concession of the Township of *Sandwich South*, and as such I require to construct a ditch under the provisions of the said Act, for the draining of my said land, and the following lands and roads will be affected:

The engineer appointed by the Municipality of the Township of Sandwich South in the County of Essex under the provisions of the ditches and water courses act 1894, having been required to do by the requisition of Edward O'Neil Owner of the North 8th Concession^s filed with the clerk of the said Township representing that he required certain work to be done under the provisions of the said act and that the following lands ~~and road~~ in the 8th Concession would be affected.

6 1/2 of N W 1/4 of Lot 2	owned by E. Stanbury
S W 1/4 " "	2 owned by John S ^r Jones
W 1/2	1 owned by Rob. Bluel
S E 1/8	2 owned by W D O'Neil
N E 1/8	1 owned by W D O'Neil

I attended at the time and place by me appointed and having examined the locality and heard the interested parties find that the ditch asked for is required

The ditch should begin at the
east side of the line between the
East and west halves of the 8th Concession
to the Colchester Town line. The west
edge of the drain shall coincide with the
west limit of the east halves of Lots 1 and 2.

The dirt shall all be cast West and leaving
a clear berm of 2 feet shall be spread over
a space from 10 to 15 feet in a workmanlike
manner. The fence shall be removed

and replaced on the west side of the ditch in as good a condition as at present

In the future repair or maintenance of the ditch the dirt shall all be cast east and spread in a workmanlike manner.

The ditch will affect the following lands in the 8th Concession²

I do therefore

award and apportion the work of making and maintaining the ditch among the several parcels of land affected and the owners thereof as follows:

C. Stansbury owner of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of N. W $\frac{1}{4}$ of Lot 2 shall make complete and maintain the drain, from stake N^o 2 North 30 rods to a point 10 rods North of stake N^o 1 which work I value at \$15⁰⁰.

Edward O'Neil owner of the N. E $\frac{3}{8}$ of Lot 2. shall make complete and maintain the drain from a point 10 rods South of stake N^o 3 South 30 rods also to stake N^o 4 which work I value at \$25⁰⁰.

John St Louis Owner of S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Lot "2" shall make complete and maintain the drain from stake N^o 4. South 30 rods. which work I value at \$15⁰⁰.

W^m D. O'Neil Owner of the N. E $\frac{3}{8}$ of Lot 1 and the S E $\frac{3}{8}$ of Lot 2. shall make complete and maintain the drain from a

I value at \$22⁵⁰.

Andrew Campbell
South East ⁹/₈ of Lot N^o 1 shall make complete
and maintain the drain from a point 15 rods
South of Stake N^o 9 South 45 rods to Stake N^o 12.
which work I value at \$22⁵⁰.

This work shall
be constructed and maintained in accordance
with the foregoing description and the annexed
Plan.

Each Portion of the ditch shall be made and
Completed before the 15th day of December a.d
1895
