

Sandwich South Council

Nov. 3rd. Council met pursuant to adjournment. All the members present. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted.

Communications were received from Clerk of Gosfield North advising the calling of a meeting of the Councils of the Townships in the Essex High School Area, in Essex Nov. 7th.; from East Windsor Hospital, statement for September; from Dept. of Planning and Development explaining Home Weaving Service; and also acknowledging receipt of requisite number of copies of the final plan of the proposed subdivision of parts of lots 306 & 307, Con. S.T.R.; from Messrs Wilson, Thompson & MacDonald three copies of a by-law to confirm and validate the sales of all lands sold by the Township and to be used as the authority in future sales, and also explaining and advising the proper procedure to be taken in a vote under the Liquor License Act; from Messrs McPhee & Holden enclosing a copy of an agreement between the Township of Sandwich West and users of water residing in Sandwich South. The School Attendance Officer submitted his report for Oct. A Summary of Legislation passed at the first Session of the Legislature of Ontario was received from the Department of Municipal Affairs.

A petition, sufficiently signed by C. Beahan & others, was presented to the Council, asking that a drain be constructed under the Municipal Drainage Act.

The amended report on the Watson Drain was received from the Twp. Engineer. The Clerk read the Engineer's Report on the McPherson Drain. Mr. A. Dawson and Mr. J. Dureno complained about the condition of the bridge on the South Talbot Road over the West Branch of the Delisle Drain and some earth which had accumulated at the North end of this bridge, impeding the free flow of the water.

The Union Gas Co. of Can. Ltd. submitted their Annual Report for the year ending March 31, 1947, memorandum as to increase in gas rates, minutes of several meetings held and form of consent to increase rates on the 1st. day of January, 1948.
