I James S Land the Engineer  
appointed by the municipality of the  
townships of Sandwick East in the  
county of Essex, under the provisions  
of the "Ditches & Watercourses Act of 1883"  
having been called by the requisition  
of John Ferry Owner of the South West  
part of Lot 13 in Con. 10 in Said  
township of Sandwick East, filed  
with the Clerk of the Said Municipality  
representing that he requires a  
drain on the South side of Said  
Lot and that it would be necessary  
to continue the drain along the North  
side of the North West Quarter of Lot 12  
in Said Con. 10, owned by  
Joseph St Louis, did attend  
at the time and place mentioned  
in Said requisition and having  
examined the locality and heard  
the parties and their witnesses, find  
that the South West part of Lot 13 in  
Con. 10 requires a drain such as I  
have described in the accompanying  
Plans & Specifications, to enable  
the proper cultivation and use of  
Said Land and I find that the North  
West part of Lot 12 in said Con. 10 owned  
by Joseph St Louis, will be benefited  
by the construction of said drain.  
And I award that John Ferry shall  
begin at Stake "O" and shall open  
up the drain East 70 rods To Stake  
Number  $3\frac{1}{2}$ . He shall maintain the  
drain from Stake "O" East  $65\frac{3}{4}$  rods To

a point  $5\frac{3}{4}$  rod East of Stake "3"

Joseph St Louis  
shall begin at Stake "3" and shall  
open up the drain East  $6\frac{1}{2}$  rod, To  
Stake "7" He shall maintain the  
drain from Stake "7" West  $6\frac{3}{4}$  rod.  
to a point  $5\frac{3}{4}$  rod East of Stake "3"

Each of the  
parties shall have his section  
of the work performed and com-  
pleted before the first day of Novem-  
ber 1885

The work shall be done in  
accordance with the accompanying  
plans and specifications

That my  
costs attendant upon the examination  
and the making of this award and  
annexed Plans are \$11.00 to be borne  
and paid as follows:

John Gerry shall pay \$5.50

Joseph St Louis shall pay \$5.50.

The Clerk of the municipality shall be paid \$2.00 each  
of the parties in this award to pay one dollar.

# Specifications of the Ferry Line drain

This drain begins at the south west angle of Lot 13 in Concession 10 Sandwich East and runs East on South side of line between Lots 12 & 13 to the  $10\frac{1}{2}$  Concession Drain.

The North edge of the drain shall coincide with the line. The dirt shall be cast straight and spread over a space of 6 feet in a workmanlike manner.

The drain shall have a bottom width of 18 inches. With side slopes of 1 to 1.

The depth of the drain is given in the enclosed plans.
