




LOT 2 DRAIN

CONCESSION IX

The Engineer Appointed by the Municipality of the Township of Sandwich South, in the County of Essex under the provisions of The Ditches and Water Courses Act, having been required so to do by the requisition of Jeremiah Bullwam Owner of the North half the South East quarter of Lot 2 in the 9th Concession of Said Township of Sandwich South, filed with the Clerk of the Said Township and representing that he required certain works to be done under the provisions of Said Act for the drainage of Said land and that certain other described lands would be benefited by the Said works, did attend at the time and place by me appointed and having examined the locality of the proposed drainage work, and having heard the interested parties find that the proposed drain is required - The location and description of the drain are as follows:

The drain begins at a stake N^o "0" at the N.E. angle of the South quarter of 1/2 of Lot 2 in the 9th Concession.

And runs West on the North side of the North line of Said South quarter. ~~72~~ rods. Thence West on the South side of Said North line ~~6 1/2~~ rods to the Blue line or Centre line of the 9th Concession - Thence North on the East side of the Blue line - (The West edge of the drain to coincide with the Blue line -) 25 rods to stake N^o "13"

Thence West on the line staked out 57 rods; Thence North 12 rods. Thence West along R. Hartley's lane ditch to the 9th Concession Road.

From stake "0 to 6" the dirt shall be disposed of on the North side of the drain, from "6 to 11" on the South side of the drain. On the 13th line on the west side of the drain, and from stake 13 to 25 on either or both sides of the drain the dirt shall be well spread over a space at least 2 rods in width.

The drain as above described will benefit the following lands in the 9th Concession of Sandwich South:

I do therefore award and apportion the work, the making and maintenance of the drain among the lands affected and the owners thereof, according to my estimate of their respective interests in the said work as follows:

Jeremiah Sullivan owner of the said North half of the South East quarter of Lot 2. shall make and maintain

Hereafter the following portions of the drain: He shall commence at Stake "0" at the East end of the drain and extend West 72 rods to Stake "6". He shall also commence at Stake 11 at the Bend line and extend North 15 rods to a point one rod South of Stake "12"; He shall also commence at Stake "13" and extend West 15 rods; He shall also open up but not maintain, the portion of the drain commencing at a point 5 rods North of Stake 18 and extending North 5 rods to the same ditch, all of which works of value at \$ 85⁰⁰.

Char Wunselberger owner of the said South quarter of the East half of Lot 2 shall open up and maintain thereafter the following portions of the drain -

He shall commence at Stake "6" and extend West $6\frac{1}{2}$ rods to the Bend line - He shall also commence at a point 3 rods West of Stake "14" and extend West 15 rods - He shall also open up but not maintain, the drain from a point 7 rods West of Stake "17" West and North 5 rods to Stake 18. all of which works of value at \$ 70⁰⁰.

Peter Sullivan owner of the South half of the North East quarter of said Lot 2. shall open up and maintain the drain from a point 6 rods West of Stake 15 - West 15 rods. He shall also open up the drain (but not maintain it) from Stake 18 North 5 rods: all of which works of value at \$ 20⁰⁰.

Michael Sullivan owner of the South half of the North quarter of the East half of said Lot "2" shall open up and maintain

Richard Hartley owner of the west half of said lot 2 shall open up and maintain there after the portion of the drain on the B line commencing one rod south of Stake 12 and extending north 15 rods Centre line of said lot 2 which work of value at \$15.00.

there after the portion of the drain commencing at a point 9 rods west of Stake 16 and extending west 10 rods to a point 7 rods west of Stake 17, which work of value at \$10.00

Rich. Hartley owner of the west half of said lot 2 shall open up the drain from a point 3 rods east of Stake 19 west 80 rods to Stake 25 at the 9th Concession Road. He shall maintain hereafter the portion of the drain commencing at a point 7 rods west of Stake 17 that is 55 rods west from the blind line and extending west and north 94 rods to the 9th Concession road. which work will according to my estimate amount in value to \$80.00 (See Margin)

Each portion of the drain shall be made and maintained in accordance with the foregoing description, and the accompanying plan:

Each portion of the drain must be fully made and completed on or before the 1st day of September A.D. 1904.

My fees and other charges attendant upon and for making this award are as follows:

To Survey and Award: \$22.00
To Stakes & charges: 3.00

Amounting in all to \$25.00 which shall be borne and paid by the several parcels of land and the respective owners thereof as set forth and charged as Engineers fees in the foregoing schedule of lands affected
