

J. Abraham J. Halford,
the engineer appointed by the Municipality of the townships of Sandwich
South in the County of Essex, under
the provisions of the Ditches and Water
Courses Act, having been required
so to do by the requisition of Frank
Lyons owner of the West part of Lot
12 in the 6th concession of Sandwich
South, filed with the Clerk of the said
township, and representing that he
required certain work to be done under
the provisions of said act for the drainage
of said lands, and that certain other
described lands and roads would be
benefited, did attend at the time and
place by me appointed, and having
examined the locality, and heard
the interested parties, find that
the said drainage work is required.

The location and description of
the drain are as follows.

The drain

begins at a stake numbered "0" planted
64 rod East from the 6th Concession road
on the North side of the North Talbot Road
and extends West along the old drain
on the North side of the North Talbot
Road, to the West boundary, then
South along the ditch on the East
side of said boundary 28 rod to the
head of the Cahill drain.

Along the North Talbot
Road the excavated earth shall be
disposed of on the North side of the drain.
It shall be well and evenly spread on

a space at least 60 feet in width - along the West Townline the excavated earth shall be disposed of on the East side and shall be well spread on a space at least 60 feet in width.

Along the North Talbot road the drain shall have a bottom width of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet; and along the West Townline the bottom width shall be three feet. Each side of the drain shall have a slope of "1 $\frac{1}{4}$ to 1" throughout. The depth of the drain at each stake shall be in accordance with accompanying schedule of depths.

The drain as above described will affect the following lands and roads in Sandwick South-

I do therefore award and apportion the making and maintenance of the drain among the lands affected and the owners thereof, according to my estimate of their respective interests in the said drain as follows:

Frank Lyons Owner of the said south west part of Lot 12 in the 6th Concession shall make

and Maintain hereafter, the portion of the drain commencing at Stake "0" and extending west 48 rods to Stake "4" which work I value at \$48⁰⁰.

Fred Moore owner of the east part of 12 & 13 in the 5th Concession shall make and Maintain hereafter the portion of the drain commencing at a point 6 rods west of Stake 7 and extending west 66 rods to Stake 13 which work I value at \$55⁰⁰.

Mathew Collins owner of the West part of "12 and 5½ of 13" in the 5th Concession and the south east part of Lot 5 in the 4th Concession shall make and Maintain hereafter the portion of the drain commencing at Stake 13 and extending west 120 rods to stakes 23. which work I value at \$70⁰⁰.

Frank Jessop owner of the North west part of Lot 30 N.T.R. shall make and Maintain hereafter the portion of the drain commencing at Stake 23 and extending west 30 rods to a point 6 rods west of Stake 25, which work I value at \$15⁰⁰.

W^m Douglass. owner of the South part of Lot 5 in the 4th Concession shall make and Maintain hereafter the portion of the drain commencing at Stake "30" and extending south 12 rods to Stake (31) which work I value at \$6⁰⁰.

The Township of Sandwich South owner of the North Talbot Road shall make and Maintain hereafter

The portions of the drain commencing at Stake 4 and extending west 42 rods value \$35⁰⁰. also commencing at a point 6 rods west of Stake 26 and extending west and south 42 rods to Stake 30. which work & value at \$26⁰⁰.

I further award that each portion of the drain shall be made and maintained in accordance with the foregoing description and specifications and that each portion of the drain shall be fully completed on or before the fifteenth day of December A.D. 1904.

My costs attendant upon and for making this award are:

To Survey and Award \$17⁵⁰

To assistants on Survey 4⁰⁰

To Clerks fees - 3⁰⁰

Amounting in all to \$24⁵⁰. which shall be borne and paid by the lands affected and the respective owners. Hereof as set forth and charged as Engineers fees in the foregoing Schedule of Lands affected.

This drain shall be known and cited as "The Lyons Moore drain"
