


# PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

#### SCIENCE DISCOVERY

THIS YEAR THE STUDENTS OF ST. MARY'S HAVE BEEN USING THE "DISCOVERY METHOD" IN THE SCIENCE PROGRAMME FOR GRADES FOUR TO EIGHT. UNDER THIS SYSTEM, THE STUDENTS MAY CHOOSE SCIENCE TOPICS OF THEIR OWN CHOICE AND DEVELOP THEM ALONG LINES OF THEIR OWN CHOOSING. MANY PROJECTS ARE DONE IN GROUPS, SOME IN PAIRS, YET OTHERS ALONE. I FIND THAT MOST STUDENTS DO BETTER WORK WHEN THEY DEAL WITH TIMELY TOPICS WHICH THEY THE EMPHASIS ISN'T SO MUCH AS FORMERLY ON FACTS, AS ON THE ABILITY TO RESEARCH TOPICS AND TAKE FROM THE CONTENT THAT WHICH IS MOST IMPORTANT AND INFORMATIVE. THE STUDENTS OFTEN USE DIAGRAMS AND/OR MODELS TO REPRESENT THE SCIENTIFIC IDEAS THEY LEARN. THIS ALLOWS THEM TO DEVELOP THEIR CREATIVE ABILITIES IN ORDER TO PUT IDEAS ACROSS WITHOUT NECESSARILY USING MEANINGLESS FACTS. ON OCCASION I HAVE TO REVERT BACK TO THE OLD METHOD IN ORDER TO KEEP MY SANITY AND HAIR. IT ALSO ALLOWS ME TO KEEP A CLOSER CHECK ON THE WEAKER STUDEN TS. THERE ARE DRAWBACKS TO THE PROGRAMME WHICH I HOPE TO GET RID OF AS WE MOVE ALONG. UNDER DRAWBACKS ONE MUST CONSIDER THE AMOUNT OF SCIENCE TEXTS AND REFERENCE BOOKS NEEDED TO COVER SO MANY INDIVIDUAL CHOICES OF TOPICS. THE CLASSROOM OFTEN LOOKS LIKE A ZOO AND PART TIME STORAGE PLACE BECAUSE OF THE STUDENTS! ENDLESS VARIETY OF OBJECTS WHICH THEY USE FOR THEIR PROJECTS. IMPOSSIBLE TO GET AROUND TO CHECK THE PROGRESS OF EACH GROUP DURING ONE PERIOD. STUDENTS WORKING TOGETHER MUST, AS YOU WOULD EXPECT, TALK OVER THEIR IDEAS AND PROGRESS OR LACK OF IT, WITH ONE ANOTHER WHICH RESULTS IN A CONSIDERABLE AMOUNT OF NOISE AT TIMES.


#### DEEP SEA SCHOOLING

#### OUR LIBRARY


OUR LIBRARY AT ST. MARY'S HAS AT PRESENT ABOUT 2300 VOLUMES. THESE CONSIST OF BOOKS ON RELIGION, SCIENCE, GEOGRAPHY, HISTORY, POETRY, BIOGRAPHY, FAIRY TALES, FICTION OF ALL KINDS, MAGAZINES, PAMPHLETS AND ENCYCLOPAEDIA.

WE HAVE BEGUN A PICTURE COLLECTION AND ITS USE WILL BE OF MORE VALUE WHEN IT IS EXTENDED.

CLASSES HAVE BEEN HELD FOR THE GRADES FROM FOUR TO EIGHT ALL YEAR. THE LIBRARY IS OPEN FOR INDIVIDUAL RESEARCH FROM 8.30 a.m. UNTIL DISMISSAL TIME.

BESIDES BOOKS WE HAVE 225 FILMSTRIPS DEALING WITH ALL SUBJECTS; TWO FILMSTRIP VIEWLEX MACHINES TWO FILMSTRIP VIEWERS, TWO FILMSTRIP PROJECTORS, AND A TYPEWRITER.

SEVERAL FAMILIES HAVE, DURING THE YEAR DONATED BOOKS TO ADD TO OUR COLLECTION AND FOR THESE WE ARE VERY GRATEFUL.

#### HISTORY OF ST. MARY'S SCHOOL

THE FIRST TWO ROOMS OF ST. MARY'S SCHOOL WERE BUILT IN 1960. THESE PROVIDED SUFFICIENT ROOM FOR THE 65 PUPILS WHO WOULD BE IN ATTENDANCE FROM THE IMMEDIATE NEIGHBOURHOOD. THOSE LIVING AT SOME DISTANCE WERE BUSSED IN TO THE SCHOOL.

AS TIME WENT ON IT BECAME APPARENT THAT A CENTRAL SCHOOL WOULD OFFER MANY ADVANTAGES AND BACKED BY SCHOOL BOARD, PROPERTY OWNERS AND OUR INSPECTOR, MR. GERALD DWYER, PREPARATIONS WERE MADE TO EXTEND THE THEN PRESENT SCHOOL TO EIGHT ROOMS.

BUILDING BEGAN IN SEPTEMBER 1963, AND WAS COMPLETED BY
THE END OF THE YEAR. PUPILS WHO HAD BEEN ATTENDING ST. MALACHY'S
ON HWY. # 3 AND ST. JOSEPH'S ON HWY. 114, AT SIX CORNERS, WERE
ADMITTED AT THE NEW YEAR, INCREASING THE ATTENDANCE TO ABOUT
235 PUPILS. THESE WERE ARRANGED IN GRADES FROM ONE TO EIGHT.
IN 1968, THE SCHOOL WAS AGAIN EXPANDED TO INCLUDE A GYMNASIUM,
A KINDERGARTEN, ANOTHER DELIGHTFUL EXPANSION--THE LIBRARY, AND
ONE CLASSROOM. THIS BROUGHT THE CLASSROOM TOTAL TO ELEVEN. A
FULL TIME LIBRARIAN WAS EMPLOYED. WE EXPECT THE SEPTEMBER ENROLMENT
WILL BE INCREASED TO 360.

WE ARE VERY PROUD OF OUR SCHOOL AND WOULD LIKE TO TAKE THIS OPPORTUNITY TO EXPRESS OUR GRATITUDE TO ALL WHO HAVE MADE IT POSSIBLE.
