We hope you will forward your contribution to help the children at Sun Parlor School and the young adults at the Sun Parlor Training Centre.

As you probably know, our Sun Parlor Training Centre is set up to aid in the further training of the young people after they become 18 years old and can no longer attend school. There are no funds available for this except through donations and appeal to the people of Essex County. At present there are 10 trainees and more will be coming in the fall. The Centre has been open now nearly two years and the young people under the able direction of Mrs. Jean Collins, are now doing a commercial job of sorting rivets, as well as several colating jobs on monthly bulletins for various organizations.

Although the Department of Education now pays all operating expenses for Sun Parlor School, classroom facilities must be provided by the Essex County Association. With growing enrollment, and transfer of Children from Churchwood School in Windsor due to ammexation and relocation of boundaries between

the two schools, additional classrooms will be badly needed by September, 1966, as well as the gymnatorium for physical training activites. The only way this money can be raised is by appeal to the public and from donations from Service Clubs, etc.

Would you please discuss this with your groups and let us know if you will assist us in this way? You will be helping the children at the school, the Trainees at the Centre, to become useful and productive citizens to the best of their individual abilities.
