Sandwich South School Area.

The Board of Public School Trustees of Sandwich South met with residents of School Section No. IV on Tuesday evening, February 4th, for the purpose of discussing the problem of coping with the increased enrolment in this school. It is expected that there will be in the neighborhood of 60 pupils attending this school in September. The Board presented three plans for enlarging the present school and also the plans for a separate two-roomed school which have already been used in Fairplay Public School and in the Charles Collins Public School. After considerable discussion a show of hands was called for and the majority of those present indicated that they favored the building of a completely new two-roomed school.

It was therefore moved by Milton Farough, and seconded by Howard Holden, that the Board proceed with plans to construct a new two-roomed school from the plans the Board had already used in Fairplay Public School and the Charles Collins Public School.

Sept 15, 1958

Completion Seen Soon For School

Construction on a new \$44,000 two-room school in Sandwich South is nearing completion and may be officially opened within a month.

The school will handle about 80 pupils for Grades 1 to 8 and will replace a school which will be torn down.

The school is located on the Anderson Twp. Line between Howard Ave. and Walker Rd.

Sandwich East, Colchester and Anderson Twps. have agreed to pay a minor share of the construction cost. Each has passed a resolution to pay sums for students who have attended or will attend school in Sandwich South.

The new school modern in design, is one of six in the township.
