Has a Richardson Family history been compiled by any local researchers?

Can anyone tell us if there was a connection between this Richardson Family, and the **Askin Family**, and also if there was a connection between this family and the author John Richardson?

Would like to know parentage of Francis Richardson, that married Mary Jane Cornwall. One reference states his father was a John Richardson from England.□

We did locate "John Richardson, from England, Boat builder, travelled from Montreal to Detroit and there built ships along with Angus Macintosh, Summer 1789." □Is he our elusive ancestor?□

According to 1851 Census.

Francis William Richardson, born on Wm. Goulin farm. His father John Richardson came from England. Francis married about 1822 to Mary Jane (Cornwall), born 22 Sept. 1806. Daughter of Wheeler Prindle Cornwall and wife Silvia () Cornwall.

Wheeler Cornwall was a Carpenter. Came with his mother, sister, and brothers in 1789. Family of John Cornwall Sr. a U.E.L. Wheeler in Detroit in 1796, then settled in Amherstburg. Records of St. John's Church show a

Wheeler Cornwall with a wife Silvia (), and then later a Wheeler Cornwall with a wife Sarah Lucinda () Cornwall. Did Wheeler marry twice? Were there children of both marriages?□ Wheeler died about 1817, as his widow

Sarah Lucinda married a Brian Chaffy. See DSGR Magazines, St. John's Church Records.

11 children of Francis Richardson and Mary Jane (Cornwall):

Uncle Charles Richardson ran store in Harrow. Someone died in Naomi Quick Webb's family and named Charles executor. He made family members take inheritance money out in trade at the store. Naomi finally settled on a set of red dishes. Hazel Butler and Fern Simetz had some remaining pieces.

Lyle Richardson - ran a hardware store in Harrow.

Lilly Richardson - m - Mr. White.

Ada Richardson - (Music teacher) m Mr. Thrasher a barber, and lived Sandwich.

Henry Richardson who married Emma Webb. SEE WEBB FAMILY.

In fact both Mr. and Mrs. Richardson are related to some of the oldest families of this district□.

Mr. Richardson's full name is Edmund Berhance Richardson. The second name is very unusual and it came from the father of Arthur Brush, who was named that. Mr. Richardson was born 77 years ago, about three miles west of Harrow, a son of the late George Richardson and his wife Alvira Lypps.

A representative of the Echo had one of the most pleasant visits in years at the home of Mr. & Mrs. Edmund B. Richardson the other day when he called to extend congratulations to them on their 55th Wedding Anniversary, and found that in spite of creeping years, that they still retained that fund of good humor that has characterized their whole life and that they recognize that it is a fine thing to be able to laugh at one's self occasionally.

For instance, Mr. Richardson said, "Do you know, if Mrs. Richardson went to heaven, the first thing she would ask for on looking around, would be for an Amherstburg Echo", while Mrs. Richardson shot back with; "And the first thing you would ask for would be a deck of cards to play a game of Euchre," and so it went!

Over 85 guests called throughout the day Sunday to express congratulations and to hope for them many more years of happy wedded life together. They were the recipients of many beautiful gifts, tokens of esteem from their many friends. Guests were present Sunday from Ecorse, Flint, Detroit, Godrich, Walkerville, Windsor, Amherstburg, and other places, and it was a joyous occasion indeed.

His grandfather came from England, but his father Francis was born on what is now the William Goulin farm. Later when his father grew up he moved to Cottam and it was quite common for him to walk through the woods with a bag of wheat on his back to the Kingsville mill to have it ground. It was quite necessary at times to stick to logs to keep from falling in the swamp. Afterwards he moved to west of Harrow, and later bought a farm on the Potlake Road.

His mother Alvira Lypps was a daughter of the late Henry Lypps whose farm was on the front road. There were two boys and a girl in the family,

Edith Richardson, who died some time ago in Harrow.

His father Francis and he were both of Conservative leanings but he doesn't think there is much difference in parties.

Mr. Richardson grew up on the Potlake Road, and was married there to Isabel, daughter of James Shepley and Dorcas Brush, whose farm was that which was later owned by Walter Atkin, and is now owned and occupied by J. A. Kennedy. The marriage was solemnized on the 8th of April 1879 at the Iler Settlement Baptist parsonage and by the then minister Rev. Mr. Osborne. They lived for a year or two at his father's home before purchasing their own home on the 3rd Concession, which 18 years ago they sold to their son Harry Richardson, and then moved to Harrow. Their family consisted of four children:

Roy Richardson, who is now on the Police Force at St. Petersburg, Florida.

Ethel Richardson, Mrs. Frank McGee of Amherstburg.

Harry Richardson, of Colchester South,

Edith Richardson, Mrs. Milton Anderson, also of St. Petersburg, Florida.

Mr. Richardson will be 78 years of age on the 8th of June, and Mrs. Richardson is 76 past. They have always enjoyed good health until some few months ago, when Mr. Richardson fell off the roof where he was doing some work, injuring himself quite badly. He has since developed a lameness, but this will likely pass away with warm weather. Probably the funniest little episode of his life as he recalls it, was the time he missed out on a church entertainment because of an accident. He was asked to shoot some chickens to dress for the church and did not notice when he was taking aim that a nest of hogs were immediately in line. After the gun discharged, he found that he had killed one of the hogs, and before he got it dressed, the church party was over, and he missed out on that one!
